














Dear Parents/carers

Welcome to this month's newsletter and to the Summer term here at Robinswood. We hope that you all had a restful break and are back to school looking forward to lots of fun activities this term and warmer weather too.

This term is 6 weeks long but there are already lots of events going on. As always, please check the dates on the back page to ensure that you keep up to date with events going on at school.



The children will be brought out by their class teacher to join you. The class teacher will have their own picnic space and food for any children whose families cannot make the event. School can provide packed school lunches for any free school meal children.

We will all join in the National Anthem together and our classes will perform a song or dance. There will be an ice-cream van, bouncy castles and a fundraising stall that the Year 6 children are running to support their end of year leaver's celebrations. Please bring some cash with you for these.

Pre-School places for September 2022

We are currently organising our Pre-school for September 2023. If you know anyone who would like their child to join us please ask them to email us at admin@robinswoodtrust.co.uk or pop into the school reception to collect a form. This needs to be completed and returned promptly. The child's date of birth needs to be between September 2019 and August 2020 for a September 2023 start.

ATTENDANCE

We are still seeing a high number of children arriving late to school. Your child starts learning the minute they walk into the classroom and are therefore often missing initial instruction. Not only is this disruptive for your child, it is for the teacher and the rest of the class.

As school starting times move forward in September, it is a really good opportunity now for children to get into a good routine of arriving on time. We are now able to issue penalty notices to parents whose children regularly arrive after the register has closed. This is a maximum fine of £120 per parent.

Please see below for a reminder of school opening times from September:

Following the Government guidelines from 1st September 2023 the school times will be as follows;

8.30am Gates open

8.35am Classroom doors open.

8.40am Gates close.

8.45am Classroom doors close.

8.50am Register closes.

8.50 - 9.00am is a late mark.

9.00am onwards will be unauthorised absence mark.



Staff will be on the gate from 8.30-8.40am to allow ENTRY and until 8.50am for EXIT ONLY. This is to allow families to walk children around to classes and leave by the gate.

Children WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER AFTER 8.40AM.

Please arrive at school on time between 8.30 – 8.40am.

Staff will be on classroom doors from 8.35am - 8.45am when the doors will close. Register will take place from 8.45am - 8.50am.

On the last day of term, Miss Walker and Mrs Andrews had a lovely afternoon celebrating with Chestnut for being the first class to complete their 'Attendance Bingo' card. The class were treated to a lovely afternoon tea, full of delicious cakes. It was also a double celebration, as they had also won the 'Best Attendance' award in KS2 for Term 4 that day. All the children have been given a RWI pack with information for you to support them at home. The children will explore a variety of activities linked to the sounds they have learnt when exploring the classroom in learning times. This is to help

they to remember and recall them.

Reception children had the wonderful experience of learning about real chicks and watching them grow and develop. They helped to look after them and even got to hold them. Next, we will be learning about giants!










Year 1

In Term 3 we were artists and in Term 4 in DT we became engineers! First, we researched different types of bridges e.g. beam, arch, cantilever and suspension. Then we designed our bridges and talked about the materials we could use. Finally, we made a plan and then created our bridges choosing the beam design. The children really enjoyed spending the afternoon being creative and having fun with construction.

Beech and Pine class have started the term with an amazing trip to Gloucester museum. This introduced our science topic on 'Living things and their habitats'. We learnt all about habitats and the different food chains we find in them. Outside we worked in a group and made some amazing food chains, which started with the sun. This term we are challenging ourselves by learning about decimals and fractions in maths. Deciding on how important the Mayans were. Exploring our new story - Arthur and the Golden Rope which is based in Iceland.

We are still doing P.E. on a Tuesday and Thursday and as the weather heats up it is very important to have an

outside P.E. kit in school.

For our DT in year 5, last term, we were investigating bread with a focus upon all the different types of bread from around the world. We investigated the process of baking bread and explored what different ingredients we could add to a basic bread dough, finally writing our own recipes and baking our own flavoured bread. 




Year 6
